# Clues

- 1 - I am a left hand pointing to a 5 branch object on top of which you can see the letters C and J. Could I have been the symbol of the lord of the castle's alchemist?
- 2 - I am engraved on a corner stone. Surrounded by two letters, the French Revolution took place 38 years later. An heir to lord Nicolas was probably living here.
- 3 - Behind me were most certainly piled up bales of hay or straw, because I am at horse carriage' height. I date back to 1830.
- 4 - My name can be associated with that of an emperor exiled to the island of Elba, but it also makes me a bigger street than I am. Nothing to do here with the lord of the castle, if only for his "greatness".
- 5 - Universal symbol of love, behind the door onto which I am cut out, were raised future hams, pâtés and sausages, favorites of the castle's, enjoyed while listening to the troubadours.
- 6 - It is said that the sick were passing through my Gothic style...some would walk back out, others would come out in a box. I once was the entrance to a hospital and I'm located a few steps away from the Pépieux Gate, near an old sheepfold. When you find me, take a group picture in front of me to validate your clue.
- 7 - Not far from me stood an old bread oven, although the name of the square bears the name of the fruit of the laying. The building I am attached to was the horse stables of the castle. I gave the time to whomever wanted to look up, on a day without clouds.
- 8 - In the XIVth century, I represented the De la Jugie family, but from wedding to wedding, no one knew how to represent me anymore. I still watch over the entrance to their old dwelling.
- 9 - My breath is of fire and the winds guide me.
- 10 - Near a religious building dedicated to Saint Etienne, I used to be surrounded by the fruits and vegetables of the priest's garden. The Lord De la Jugie is buried on the other side of the stone wall. Although my presence remains unexplained today, one of my functions may have been to give water to different souls. Completely dry these days, my mysteries remain, like the dry bed of an old spring.
- 11 - Close to an old gas station, and facing the former mechanic's place, I'm waiting for you to finish your adventure. On a stone wall, you will find me...the 4 figure code already you know...115 minus 210, plus 160, minus 63, is the number of the clue where you will find me.

Scan the QR code located in the back of the box and close the box with the QR code still inside. Please mix up the code on the box before leaving.
